I am pleased to send you the latest edition of the Burton Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust Cancer Services directory, compiled with the aim of providing easy access for Primary Care Health Teams requiring information on the referral, treatment and ongoing management of cancer patients.

The Derby Cancer Centre is an umbrella team encompassing the cancer services provided in Southern Derbyshire across both acute and community care. As well as receiving referrals direct from Primary Care for suspected cancer cases, the Centre also receives tertiary referrals from Burton and Chesterfield Cancer Units for certain patient treatments.

The directory therefore provides information both for GPs who refer direct to Derby and for those whose initial referral is to another Trust but where subsequent treatment e.g. radiotherapy, is carried out in Derby.

The directory will be updated annually to take into account change of personnel and developments in services, and replacement pages will be issued as appropriate.

General Enquiries –

Outpatient Clinics:

Symptomatic Clinics: All new symptomatic patients are seen in the three combined clinics each week. Triple assessment by clinical, ultrasound and/or mammographic examinations is undertaken as indicated for the individual patient at the first visit. Further tests including aspiration, cytology and core biopsy are available as required.

Breast reconstruction surgery is provided at Queen’s Hospital (i.e tissue expansion and latissimus dorsi operations). Patients who require more extensive plastic surgery, will be seen at Selly Oak Hospital.

Familial Cancer Service:

Individuals at potentially increased risk of breast cancer due to their family history may be referred for formal risk assessment and counselling, and appropriate subsequent management. This includes the availability of screening mammography, referral to Clinical Genetics for genetic investigation and, where appropriate, risk reducing surgery.

Combined breast cancer follow-up clinics alongside nurse led follow up clinic, are held weekly, with input available from surgery, clinical oncology, breast care nursing and radiology.

Children's malignancies are uncommon and only rarely will children be referred with a diagnosis of cancer as a primary suspicion. Consequently the initial investigations leading to such a diagnosis often lies with any one of the paediatricians.

The suspected malignancy cases have their preliminary investigations done at Queen's Hospital and for definitive diagnosis and management they are referred to the tertiary Centre. Birmingham Children's Hospital is the main referral centre, we also refer patients to Queen's Medical Centre, Nottingham and Leicester Royal infirmary . Queen's Hospital, Burton is accredited as a Level 1 centre

Referral pathways

All children who are thought to have a serious illness will always be seen as an emergency urgently and avoid outpatients referrals as it may delay the diagnosis.

- For urgent outpatient appointment preferably contact the paediatric consultant on service by telephone, usually via their secretary, or fax urgent referral letter.
- In case of clear suspicion of malignancy contact Dr T Jacob Samuel (lead in paediatric oncology team) or the service week consultant.
- On-call paediatric registrar for emergency review/admission.
- Existing patients have open access via Dr Samuel's secretary or via the Community Paediatric Nursing services.

Family History Service

There has been a recent increase in public awareness that a history of cancer in their family may increase their individual risk of developing cancer. This demand, together with the introduction of guidelines for screening individuals with a family history of cancer and rapid development in the field of cancer genetics, have led to the introduction of this new service.

At present we are focusing on 3 cancer sites:

- Breast
- Colorectal
- Ovarian

The service aims to produce guidelines to classify an individual's increased risk of developing a cancer due to their family history into 3 groups:

Low risk

The risk is broadly the same as the general population and no action is required. Referral to the Family History Service is unnecessary, but individuals will be seen if they cannot be reassured in primary care.

Moderate risk

A confirmed family history that significantly increases an individual's risk of developing a cancer. Individuals will be seen by site specific specialists who will assess their risk and offer appropriate screening.

High risk

A strong family history spanning through generations that raises the possibility of a cancer causing gene affecting their family. A small number of individuals will fall into this category and they will be given the opportunity to discuss their risk with the Cancer Geneticist and maybe offered genetic testing if appropriate.

A set of guidelines are being developed for each of the 3 cancer sites. Standard referral forms for General Practitioners, together with guidelines for referral have already been distributed for breast and ovarian cancer. Guidelines for referral and referral forms are being developed for colorectal cancer.

Local Guidelines on the Use of Cancer 2 Week Wait Referral Criteria

DERBY-BURTON CANCER NETWORK

Policy for the referral of all patients on the Cancer Two-week Wait

All patients referred by primary care practitioners on the cancer “two-week wait” in line with the Referral Guidelines for Suspected Cancer (2000, revised 2005) should be referred by fax or email to the local teams

General

- 2WW referrals can now be made to Burton through the Choose and Book system. Please continue to use the Cancer 2ww proforma for all urgent cancer 2 week wait referrals.
- Please ensure that the referral proforma is fax to .
- It is essential that the referral criteria code(s) are indicated on the forms (for audit purposes). Incomplete forms will be returned.

Specific Tumour Sites

Colorectal Cancer

- GPs are encouraged to carry out a rectal examination prior to referral on all patients where a colorectal cancer is suspected.
-

Breast Cancer

- Non-urgent referrals should be made in the usual way and not on the urgent 2 week wait proforma.

Gynaecological Cancers

- Those patients with indications for ‘early referral’ should be referred in the usual way and not on the urgent 2 week wait proforma.
- Patients with abnormal cervical smears classified as invasive or glandular should be referred under the 2 week wait criteria

Urological Cancers

- For age specific PSA please follow National Guidelines at present i.e. upper limit of normal = 2.8 at age 50 yrs rising to 5.3 at age 70yrs. Clinical biochemistry are reviewing how PSAs will be reported.

Skin Cancers

- Please do not use the urgent 2 week wait referral proforma for patients with suspected/proven basal cell carcinomas. Please refer in the usual way.

Head & Neck Cancers

- Please refer to as per guidelines.

Brain Tumours

- Please refer as described. Patients under the age of 65yrs will be seen by the Neurologists; patients over 65yrs by Health Care of the Elderly physicians.

Sarcomas

- GPs are encouraged to telephone one of the orthopaedic surgeons to discuss patients with suspected soft tissue and osteosarcomas.

Children’s Tumours

- GPs are encouraged to telephone the on-call consultant paediatrician to discuss children with suspected cancers and confirm referral by fax (see pathway)
- There is no need to use a code on the referral proforma for suspected children’s tumours
